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This assignment focuses on preparing effective slides for Capstone presentations. The target time is 12 minutes for the main presentation, followed by 2 minutes of questions.

- 1. Create a clean PDF version of the slides for your final presentation. If your presentation has elements that do not map well to a PDF version (e.g., video segments, demos), include slides with the appropriate comments in their places.
- 2. Create a document (PDF) that outlines the following information for each slide of Question 1:
 - (a) Budgeted time.
 - (b) Main points made orally (whether mentioned on the slide or not).
 - (c) Primary target audience group (general public, computer scientist, or area expert).
 - (d) Features that help match the material with the target audience.

Include also any additional notes that help in interpreting how the slides relate to the live presentation.

- 3. Describe, in detail, how the presentation would be altered if the target time were 8 minutes. Indicate which slides would be skipped or substantially altered, as well as how the material in Question 2 would be changed.
- 4. Repeat Question 3, but for a target time of 15 minutes.
